An Act Concerning: Children
Amends the Children's Privacy Protection and Parental Empowerment Act.

An Act Concerning: Regulation
Creates the Accountable Care Organization Clinical Laboratory Testing Advisory Board Act.

Bill No.: HB 3659

An Act Concerning: Local Government

Limits the outside employment of board members of the Regional Transportation Authority, Chicago Transportation Authority and Metra.

An Act Concerning: Education

Permits special education cooperatives to apply for school maintenance project grants.

An Act Concerning: State Government

Authorizes the Department of Human Services to report substantiated cases of financial exploitation.

An Act Concerning: Public Employee Benefits

Excludes individuals who can or do contribute to a Taft-Hartley pension plan from the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund.

Allows the IDFPR to set licensing examination formats by rule for professional engineers, structural engineers and professional land surveyors.

Reduces the categories of items that electronic manufacturers and collectors must segregate and weigh for reporting purposes.
